	Scope out potential formats for meetings

	Hold your first meeting	 Is there a suitable meeting room in the local area? Provide an agenda Explain the purpose of the meeting Provide name badges and ask Members to introduce themselves Provide a 12 month plan template for attendees to take home and think about Set a date for the next meeting
	Develop your 12 month plan	 Ask for everyone's input and collectively agree on the plan Consider the practical implications
